It receives information from your senses about conditions inside and outside your body. Your brain analyses this information with amazing speed and sends out messages that control your body. For example, when you put your hand in very hot water, you think "Oh! That hurts!" and you pull your hand from the water. This is what happens in your brain. Your hand sends a message to your brain: "Very hot!" and your brain immediately sends a message to your hand: "Take your hand out." Your brain also stores memories of things that happened to you in the past and this makes remembering easy. Finally, your brain controls your lungs, heartbeat, body temperature and the actions of your stomach. The brain cells create and send more messages than all the phones in the entire world. An average person uses only about 10% of the brain's capacity.






